**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)**

- The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable various works to be carried out, it intends, to make, an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
- Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in:
- (a) Bawdale Road, between No's 36  
(b) Copleston Road, between No's 65  
(c) Forsyth Gardens, between No's 40 and Lorrimore Road  
(d) Lavington Street, opposite No's 11 and Great Suffolk Street  
(e) Plough Lane, side of 379 Lordship Lane  
(f) Raymouth Road, between No's 2 – No's 10
- The alternative route for affected traffic will as indicated by the signs displayed
- Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
- The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- The works will be in operation for (2a) 9th – 24th October (2b) 9th – 19th October (2c) 6th October (2d) 11th – 24th October (2e) 11th – 13th October (2f) 9th – 11th October
