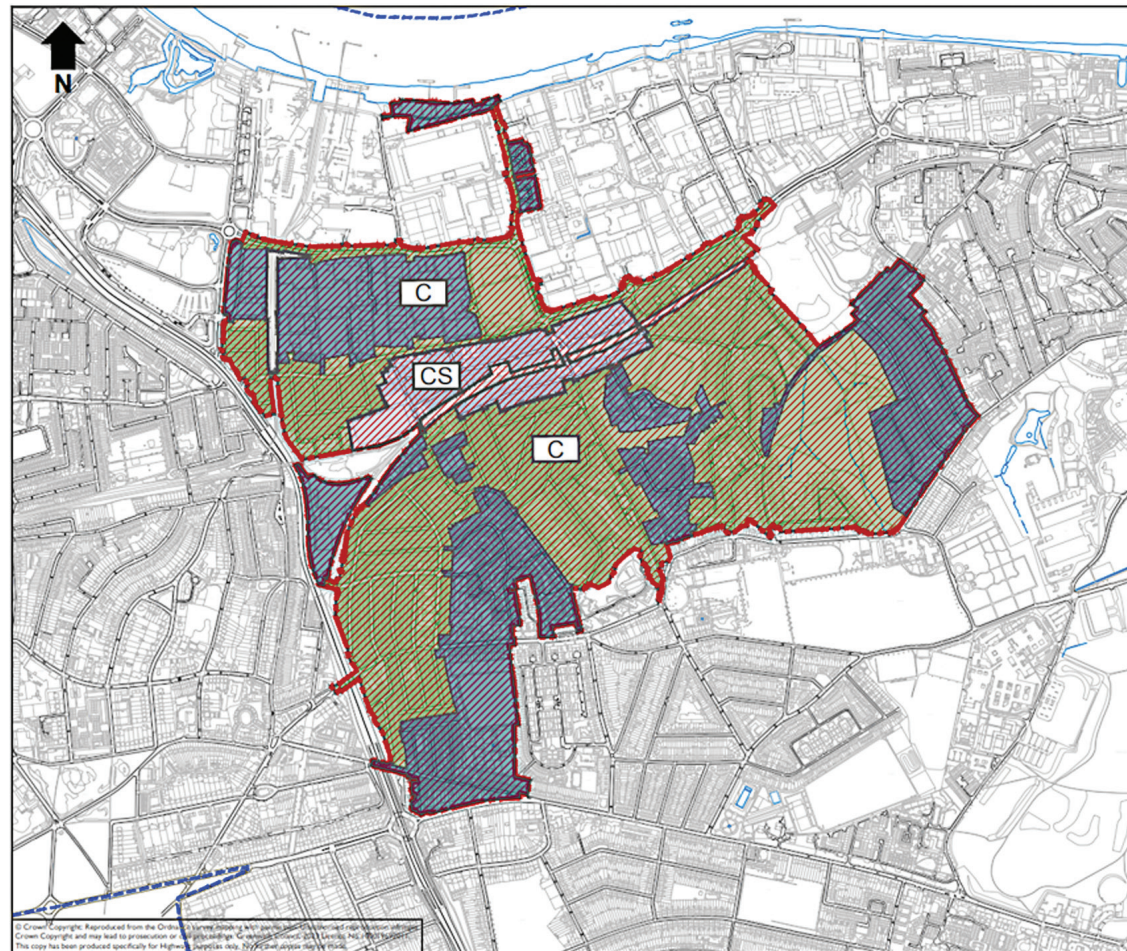

 The Greenwich (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*
 The Greenwich (Charged For-Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Greenwich (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The general effect of the Orders would be to:
 - Replace the proposed 'Permit Holders Zone CS or Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm Max stay 2 Hours No return within 3 hours' bays with 'Permit Holders Zone CS or Limited Waiting Max stay 2 Hours No return within 3 hours Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm and on Match Days Permit Holders Zone CS Mon-Sun and Bank Holidays 9am-9pm' bays throughout the CS CPZ as shown on the plan.
 - Replace the existing 'No Waiting Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm' restrictions with 'No Waiting Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm and on Match Days Mon-Sun and Bank Holidays 9am-9pm' restrictions throughout the CS CPZ and C CPZ as shown on the plan, except where proposed double yellow line 'at any time' waiting restrictions or parking bays are provided.
 - Replace the proposed 'Payment parking Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm/Permit Holders Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm Zone C' bays with 'Payment parking Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm/Permit Holders Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm Zone C and on Match Days Payment Parking Mon-Sun and Bank Holidays 9am-9pm/ Permit Holders Zone C Mon-Sun and Bank Holidays 9am-9pm' bays on Anchor and Hope Lane west side, from opposite the junction with Atlas Gardens to opposite Nos. 3 & 4 Atlas Gardens, and from opposite Nos. 35 & 36 Derrick Gardens to opposite No. 100.
 - Replace the proposed 'Permit holders only past this point area Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm Zone C' restrictions with 'Permit holders Zone C only past this point area Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm and on Match Days Permit holders only past this point Zone C Mon-Sun and Bank Holidays 9am-9pm' restrictions in Zone C on The Birches.
 - Replace the proposed and existing 'Permit Holders or Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm Max stay 2 Hours No return within 3 hours Zone C' bays with 'Permit Holders Zone C or Limited Waiting Max stay 2 Hours No return within 3 hours Mon-Sat 9am-6.30pm and on Match Days Permit Holders Zone C Mon-Sun and Bank Holidays 9am-9pm' bays throughout the C CPZ as shown on the plan.
 - update the map tiles attached to The Greenwich (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2018 and The Greenwich (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2018 so as to reflect the provisions referred to in sub-paragraph (a) to (e).
