## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (GILKES PLACE)

#### (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES)

- NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN that to enable development works to be carried out by Aquinna Homes Plc or it's appointed contractor, the Council of the London Borough of Southwark has made an order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict vehicles from entering a section of Gilkes Place.
- Prohibit vehicles from entering, proceeding, stopping, waiting and loading in a section of carriageway on Gilkes Place. The prohibition applies to 25 metres of carriageway from the junction of Gilkes Crescent.
- 3. The alternative route for affected traffic will be via Dulwich Village, East Dulwich Grove,
- The Order is already in force and it is anticipated that the works will be completed by the 30th October 2023.
- The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

# ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (EMBA STREET)

### (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, TEMPORARY LIFTING OF ONE WAY RESTRICTION)

- The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable mains replacement works to be carried out, it has made an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
- Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time between number 56 and the junction of Wilson Grove.
- 3. The alternative route for affected traffic; Surrounding roads as applicable.
- Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it
  is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
- The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- 6. The works will be in operation from the 16th of October to the 20th of October 2023.
