1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable a crane operation to be carried out, it has made an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in Heygate Street, between Sayer Street and Rodney Place
3. The alternative route for affected traffic is A201 New Kent Road, Elephant and Castle, Walworth Road.
