(BOMBAY STREET)**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable utility work to be carried out by Thames Water, it has made an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in Bombay Street, between Southwark Park Road and number 20.
3. An alternative route for affected traffic is not available, access will be maintained where possible.
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
5. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
6. The works will be in operation between the 13th of November and the 21st of November 2023

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable utility works to be carried out by Fibreworks UK, it intends to make an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time between Blackfriars Road and Rennie Street.
3. The alternative route for affected traffic is Stamford Street, Rennie Street.
4. The prohibition will not apply to cyclists.
5. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
6. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
