(LAVINGTON STREET)**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable utility works to be carried out, it intends to make an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time on Lavington Street at the junction of Great Suffolk Street.
3. The alternative route for affected traffic is Southwark Street, Blackfriars Road, Union Street.
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
5. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable bridge inspection works to be carried out, it intends to make an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time on Manor Place, between Crampton Street and Angel Lane.
3. The alternative route for affected traffic is Manor Place, Walworth Road, Amelia Street, Crampton Street.
