**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)
(ROUEL ROAD)**

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable utility works to be carried out, it has made an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in:
(a) Rouel Road, between Enid Street and Spa Road.
3. The alternative route for affected traffic; (2a) Spa Road, The Grange, Abbey Street.
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
5. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
6. The works will be in operation for (2a) 20th November to the 22nd of December 2023.

(MANOR PLACE)**

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable bridge inspection works to be carried out, it has made an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time on Manor Place, between Crampton Street and Angel Lane.
3. The alternative route for affected traffic is Manor Place, Walworth Road, Amelia Street, Crampton Street.
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
5. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
6. The works will be in operation on the 29th of November until the 1st of December 2023. The works will only be carried out between 22:00 and 06:00 each day.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A
THE (RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC/PARKING) SPECIAL EVENTS ORDER 2023
(BOROUGH HIGH STREET SLIP ROAD/ BOROUGH HIGH STREET)**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark, and in consultation with Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 16 (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to facilitate The Annual Remembrance Day Service
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
(a) entering, exiting or proceeding in (Northbound A3) Borough High Street Slip Road, between the main connecting carriageway of Borough High Street and Southwark Street.
(b) stopping in the loading, unloading and disabled persons' vehicles bays in Borough High Street. between No's 30 – 34, No's 60 – 62, No's 75 – 85, and No's 107 – 111 (Eastern Leg) between 09:00am – 12:00pm
(c) stopping in the solo motorcycle bays located in Borough High Street (Slip Road) between No's 54 – 58 (Western Leg) between 09:00am – 12:00pm
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
(a) any vehicle being used for the purposes of this event or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes
(b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by the London Borough of Southwark.
(c) The Order will be effective on Sunday 12th November between the hours of 09:00am – 12:00pm
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force, the alternative route for affected traffic will be adjacent roads as applicable.

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable a crane operation to be carried out, it has made an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time on East Street between Walworth Place and 28 East Street.
3. The alternative route for affected traffic is Walworth Road, Cadiz Street, Walworth Place, Bronti Close, Blackwood Street, East Street.
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
5. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
6. The works will be in operation on the 27th of November 2023. If works are unavoidably delayed they will take place on the 22nd of January 2024.
