 (c) Champion Hill, between Langford Green and Dog Kennel Hill
 (d) Grove Hill Road, between Dog Kennel Hill and the side of No's 209
 (e) Red Post Hill, at it's junction with Sunray Avenue
 (f) Sunray Avenue, between No's 113 and Red Post Hill
 (g) Borland Road, between No's 10 and No's 16, located between Reynolds
 (h) Janeway Place, between No's 8 to Wilson Grove
 (i) Lavington Street, between Great Suffolk Street and Ewer Street
 (j) Manor Place, between Angel Lane and Crampton Street
 (k) Munton Road, between Balfour Place and Rodney Place
 (l) Parkers Row, at it's junction of Dockhead to it's blocked end
- The alternative route for affected traffic (2a) Camberwell Road, Walworth Road, Heygate Street, Rodney Road, Flint Street, Thurlow Street. Albany Road, Wells Way, Southampton Way, New Church Road, Bowyer Place, (cyclists Portland Street, Westmoreland Road) Camberwell Road, Bowyer Place, New Church Road, Cottage Green, Wells Way. (2b, 2c, 2d) Demark Hill, Peckham Road, Clayton Road, Hanover Park, Rye Lane, Peckham Rye, East Dulwich Road (2e, 2f) East Dulwich Grove, Lordship Lane, Grove Vale, Champion Park, Denmark Hill. (2g) Stuart Road, Cheltenham Road, Hichisson Road. (2h) Wilson Grove, Janeway Street, Janeway Place (2i) as indicated by the signs displayed (2j) Manor Place, Crampton Street, Amelia Street, Walworth Road (2k) New Kent Road, Elephant & Castle, Walworth Road. Heygate Street. Rodney Road. Rodney Road. Flint Street. East Street. Old Walworth Road, Heygate Street, Rodney Road. Rodney Road, Flint Street, East Street, Old Kent Road (2l) not applicable
- The existing restriction in place, at Rye Lane and Hanover Park for 'buses and taxis only' will be suspended to allow motorised vehicles and motorcycles to use these roads as an alternative route for (2b, 2c, 2d)
- 5. The existing 'one-way' working in Lavington Street, will be made 'two-way' for access and
- 6. The existing 'one-way' working in Munton Road, will be made 'two-way' for access and egress purposes for (2k)
- Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
- The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- The works will be in operation for (2a) 11th 16th December, between 20:00hrs and 05:00hrs. (2b, 2c, 2d) 6th 8th December, between 20:00hrs and 05:00hrs (2e, 2f)4th 6th December, between 20:00hrs and 05:00hrs (2g) 5th December (2h) 4th December 2023 20 February 2024 (2i) 2nd December, with back up dates of the 9th December (2j) 8th 10th December, between 22:00hrs and 06:00hrs (2k) 2nd-3rd and 9th 10th December (2l) 4th December 2023 8th January 2024 9.

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that on 23 November 2023 it has made the above orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The effects of the 'Charged-for parking places' Order, (within Controlled Parking Zone 'K') are:(a) in CAMBERWELL STATION ROAD remove a total of 49.5m 'pay' parking on the north-west side (i) 5m opposite No. 1, (ii) 5.5m opposite No. 5, (iii) 20m o/s Railway Arch 361, and (iv) 19m o/s Railway Arches 362 to 364);
- Arches 362 to 364);
 (b) in CAMBERWELL STATION ROAD (i) north-west side o/s Railway Arches 362 to 364 add new 'permit-holders only' parking 5m in length, and (ii) south-east side opposite Railway Arches 362 to 364 remove 'permit-holders only' parking bay 25.5m in length;
 (c) in KNATCHBULL ROAD o/s The Sacred Heart RC Church (i) north-west side add new 'pay' parking 7m in length, and (ii) south-east side reduce in length by 16.5m an existing 'pay' parking bay (35.5m remains):
- (d) in STATION TERRACE north-east side reduce in length by 1m an existing 'permit-holders only' parking bay (17.5m remains).
- 3. The effects of the 'Free parking places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping restrictions' Order are:-(a) in CAMBERWELL STATION ROAD south-east side o/s Nos. 1 and 3 Camberwell Station Road remove existing free 'short stay' parking 13m in length and replace with new DYLs; (b) in CAMBERWELL STATION ROAD (i) north-west side o/s Railway Arches 362 to 364 add 5m new DKBs to existing DYLs, and (ii) south-east side opposite Railway Arches 362 to 364, convert 14m existing SYLs to DYLs; (c) in CAMBERWELL STATION ROAD north-west side either side of the new cycle track add new DYLs with contiguous DKBs (i) o/s Railway Arches 362 to 364 (7.5m), and (ii) o/s Railway Arch 361 (24m).

 (d) in KNATCHBULL ROAD o/s The Sacred Heart RC Church north-west side (i) install two new electric vehicle only re-charging points each 5m in length, which may be used by electric vehicles for re-charging only either for a max stay of 4hrs (no return within 2hrs between the hours of 8 am to 6 pm Mondays Saturdays), or without time limit for the remaining hours in the week, (ii) remove 17m existing SYLs to accommodate the parking changes, and (iii) convert 12.5m existing SYLs to DYLs; (e) in KNATCHBULL ROAD o/s The Sacred Heart RC Church south-east side extend existing SYLs by 16.5m to accommodate for changes to parking; and (f) add new DYLs and amend existing DYLs on both sides in CAMBERWELL STATION ROAD between its boundary with Transport for London 'red route' (a point 23m south-west of the south-western kerbline of Camberwell New Road) and a point 3.5m south-west of the north-eastern boundary wall of No. 69 Camberwell Station Road (Woodrow Court), and in STATION TERRACE (at its junction with Camberwell Station Road) to accommodate changes to parking and to amend the layout to accommodate kerb-line build-outs and a new segregated cycle track.

 NOTES: (1) 'permit-holders only' parking refers to parking places for holders of valid parking permits within the Controlled Parking Zone 'K' and 'pay' parking refers to parking places in which paid ticket holders are permitted to park within the permitted hours. (2) 'SYLs' refer to 'timed waiting restrictions' (single yellow lines), 'DYLs' refer to 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines), and 'DKBs' refer to 'at any time' loading restrictions (double kerb blips). (3) All measurements are in metres 'm' and are approximate. (4) Parking charges are listed on www.southwark.gov.uk/parking.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order/s or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order/s may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
