CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 A202 GLA SIDE ROAD (CAMBERWELL
STATION ROAD) VARIATION ORDER 2024

- Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- The general nature and effect of the Order will to:
 - replace the existing Loading & Disabled Persons' Vehicle bay on Camberwell Station Road outside No.296a Camberwell New Road with a 5.8 metre Loading only operating 'No Stopping on any Day 7am-7pm, except Loading 20 mins';
 - replace existing single red lines on Camberwell Station Road operating 'No Stopping on any Day 7am-7pm' with double red lines operating 'No stopping at any Time'.
- The road which would be affected by the Order is the A202 GLA Road – Camberwell Station Road in the London Borough of Southwark.

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the order is to allow new telecom connection works to be undertaken on the A200 Tooley Street.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons' Vehicles bay outside No. 160 Tooley Street.

The Order will be effective between 9:00 PM on the 9th January 2024 and 11:59PM on the 9th January 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
 - anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER
2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the order is to allow telecom repair works to be undertaken on the A200 Southwark Street.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - stopping in the e-taxi charging bay adjacent to no.49 Southwark Street;
 - stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons' vehicle bay adjacent to no.49 Southwark Street;
 - stopping in the Loading and Disabled Persons' Vehicles Bay outside Nos.38-40 Southwark Street;
 - entering or exiting O'Meara Street at its junction with Southwark Street.
The Order will be effective between 08:00 AM on the 7th January 2024 and 6:00 PM on the 7th January 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
 - anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Union Street; Borough High Street; Southwark Street to normal route of travel.

(LAVINGTON STREET)**

TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING/RELOCATION OF MOTORCYCLE BAYS AND WAITING & LOADING RESTRICTIONS

- The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that because of development works, it intends, to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily suspend and relocate sections of motorcycle bays in Lavington Street
- Whilst the restriction is in place, and whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to wait, including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading at any time in:
- Whilst the works are in progress or whilst the authorised traffic signs are displayed, the following sections of parking bays will be suspended or relocated in Lavington Street, between Ewer Street and Great Suffolk Street:-
 - Lavington Street, north east kerb, the 21.99m, stretch of Parking bays (paid – phone or cash) located opposite it's junction with Ewer Street, will be suspended.
 - Lavington Street, north east kerb, the two sections of Parking bays 30.54m/11.21m and 58.20m (paid – phone or cash) located between No's 1 – No's 11 (Europoint House) will be suspended
 - Lavington Street, south west kerb, the 33.65m stretch of permit holders bays located outside No's 25 will be suspended
 - Lavington Street, south west kerb, the 35.51m stretch of motor cycle bays located opposite No's 1 – No's 11 will be suspended and relocated on the north east kerb, from the end of the existing 19.76m of stretch of Parking bays (paid – phone or cash) located near the junction with Great Suffolk Street
 - Lavington Street, south west kerb, the 16.34m stretch of Parking bays (paid – phone or cash) located near the junction with Great Suffolk Street will be suspended.
 - Lavington Street, 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions will be introduced on the north east kerb line located between Ewer Street for approximately 112m west.
 - Lavington Street, east side, the cycle lane contraflow located between Ewer Street and Lavington Street will be suspended
- Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
- The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- The restriction will be in place between the 3rd January 2024 - 2nd July 2025
