### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

#### THE A3200 GLA ROAD (SOUTHWARK STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the order is to allow manhole cover and frame replacement works to take place on the A3200 Southwark Street. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle;
  - except cycles from turning right from Borough High Street into Southwark Street;
  - from stopping in the taxi only bay outside No.1 Southwark Street.
- The Order will be effective between 9:00 PM on the 15th January 2024 and 5:00 AM on the 16th January 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
  - anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. Borough High Street; Newington Causeway; St Georges Close; Waterloo Road; Stamford Street; Southwark Street to normal route of travel.
