ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (OLD KENT ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London having consulted with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.

2. The purpose of the order is to allow electrical connection works to be undertaken on the A2 Old Kent Road.

3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle including cyclists from:

- (1) turning right from Old Kent Road into Peckham Park Road;
- (2) proceed in a southerly direction on Peckham Park Road from its junctions with Old Kent Road and Green Hundred Road, local access will be maintained.

The Order will be effective between 08:00 AM on the 10th February 2024 and 6:00 PM on the 25th February 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:

- (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Old Kent Road, New Cross Road, Amersham Road, Parkfield Road, Lewisham Way, New Cross Road, Queens Road, Peckham High Street, Buller Close to normal route of travel. For cyclists Old Kent Road, Commercial Way, Bird in Bush Road, Green Hundred Road to normal route of travel.

THE A3200 GLA ROAD (SOUTHWARK STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.

2. The purpose of the order is to enable repair works to frames and covers in the carriage way to be undertaken on the A200 Southwark Street.

3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle except cycles from entering or proceeding in a westerly direction on Southwark Street between its junctions with Blackfriars Road and Burrell Street.

The Order will be effective between 10:00 PM on the 15th February 2024 and 5:00 AM on the 16th February 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:

- (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Blackfriars Road, Borough Road, Borough High Street to normal route of travel.
