ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (CRUCIFIX LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable crane operation works to take place at A200 Crucifix Lane.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on Crucifix Lane between its junctions with Barnham Street and Bermondsey Street. The Order will be effective at certain times from 8.00 AM on the 30th March 2024 until 6.00 PM on the 30th April 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

The Order will also close the northern footway on Crucifix Lane between its junction with Barnham Street and Shand Street.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
