ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3200 GLA ROAD (SOUTHWARK STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the order is to allow London Bridge Bus Station works to be undertaken on or near the A3200 Southwark Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle, except buses from stopping on Southwark Street northern kerb line between its junctions with Redcross Way and Stoney Street.

The Order will be effective between 9:00 PM on the 22nd March 2024 and 5:00 AM on the 25th March 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
