TEMPORARY "AT ANY TIME" PARKING, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS BROXHOLM ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunication works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from parking and waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) at any time in that length of Broxholm Road which lies between No. 2 Broxholm Road and No. 22 Broxholm Road (both sides of the road).
- The ban on parking and waiting by vehicles in the length of Broxholm Road referred to above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. The Order would come into force on 29th April 2024 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out on 29th April 2024 between 11.30 am and 5.30 pm but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 1 month.
