## TEMPORARY CLOSURE – ALBERT EMBANKMENT RIVER SIDE WALK

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable filming to take place along the Albert Embankment River Side Walk, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban pedestrians from entering that length of the Albert Embankment River Side Walk, which lies between the north side of the entrance to Lambeth Pier and the walkway leading to the north side of Westminster Bridge.
- Alternative routes for pedestrians will be available via Lambeth Palace Road, Westminster Bridge Road and Westminster Bridge and vice versa.
- The ban will only have effect at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs and they will not apply to any person connected with the filming.
- 4. The Order will come into force on 15th May 2024 and will continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 days. In practice it is anticipated that filming will take place between 8 pm and 5 am on the 15th and 16th May 2024, but if the filming cannot be completed during that time, the order may also have effect at other times on those days.
