TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - LEIGHAM VALE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable bridge examination Works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Leigham Vale which lies between the south side of the southernmost railway bridge over Leigham Vale and the northwest side of the north-westernmost railway bridge over Leigham Vale.
- 2. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Norwood Road, York Hill and Knollys Road and vice versa.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 20th May 2024 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 10 pm on 20th May 2024 and 6 am on 21st May 2024 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent

days up to the maximum period of 1 month.
