ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - MEPHAM STREET

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Network Rail to carry out scaffolding works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of Mepham Street which lies between a point 20 metres south-east of Whichcote Street and a point 35 metres north-west of Waterloo Road.
- Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Waterloo Road, Tenison Way and vice-versa.
- The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 2nd June 2024 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would be in force on 2nd June 2024 between 8 am and 4 pm, with a backup date of 9th June between 8 am and 4 pm. If the works

cannot be carried out or completed on those dates or during that time, the Order would also have effect on subsequent dates and times within the maximum period of 1 month.
