ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS - SOUTH ISLAND PLACE

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of South Island Place which lies between Hackford Road and a point 3.5 metres south-west of the common boundary of No. 68 South Island Place and No. 83 Clapham Road
- 2. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Hackford Road, Caldwell Street and Clapham Road.
- The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 24th May 2024 and continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place on 24th May 2024, with backup dates of 27th May 2024 and 29th May 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
