- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable BT ducting works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of South Oak Road which lies between Valley Road and a point 40 metres south-east of Valley Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via: Valley Road, Curtis Field Road and South Oak Road and vice versa.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 28th May 2024 for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
