## HYNDMAN STREET IMPROVEMENTS

The London Borough of Southwark (Loading places and Waiting restrictions) (Hyndman Street improvements)
Order 2024

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that on 23 May 2024 it has made the above order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The effects of Order are in HYNDMAN STREET to install a new loading bay, 12 metres in length, which may be used for the purpose of loading only 'at any time' every day of the week (max stay 1 hour, and no return within 2 hours) south-east side north-east of its junction with Old Kent Road and remove 12 metres of existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) to accommodate the new loading bay. NOTE: All measurements are in metres and are approximate.
- 3. Copies of the Order, which will come into force on 28 May 2024, and of all other relevant documents are available for inspection at Highways, Southwark Council, Environment, Neighbourhoods and Growth, 3rd floor hub 2, 160 Tooley Street, London SE1 2QH, by appointment only. - 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
