NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth made The Lambeth (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No.42) Order 2024 and The Lambeth (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No.38) Order 2024 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

- 3. The changes are necessary to provide secure parking space for residents who do not have the space and/or ability to park bicycles in their homes. Hangars aim to reduce theft, improve the street scene and encourage people to choose cycling as a safe and secure method of transport over the private car. The use of more sustainable modes of transport will also contribute to improved air quality in the borough
- in line with council cleaner air policies.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
