## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

### **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – WANDSWORTH ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable the installation of high voltage connection works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles proceeding in a northerly direction on Wandsworth Road from turning left into Carnation Way.
2. An alternative route for vehicles affected by the banned left turn would be available via Wandsworth Road, Kennington Lane, South Lambeth Road, Parry Street and Wandsworth Road.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 8th July 2024 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 8th and 10th July 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may also have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 1 month.
