BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)** (RUSHWORTH STREET)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that in the interest of public safety, it intends to make an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road. 2

Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs, barriers or road markings

- are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in Rushworth Street, between Kings Bench Street and Pocock Street. 3. The alternative routes for affected traffic will be adjacent roads as applicable.
- 4. Exemptions may be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said prohibition being carried out for safety purposes.
- 5 The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said road closure. or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- 6 The prohibition will be in place between the 3rd of July and the 6th of July, and may be in place
