ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - ST.JULIAN'S FARM ROAD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water to carry out repair works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles entering in that length of St Julian's Farm Road which lies between the porth-western kerb-line of

Knights Hill and a point 21 metres west of Knight's Hill.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via (a) Knights Hill, Wolfington Road and Casewick Road and (b) Casewick Road, Thornlaw Road and Knight's Hill.

 The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
 The Order will come into force on 26th July 2024 and will

continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take place between 26th and 27th July 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may also have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 1 month.
