

**LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK**

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)**  
**(RISBOROUGH STREET)**

**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable development works to be carried out, it has made an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time on Risborough Street, between numbers 15 and 21.
3. The alternative route for affected traffic will be shown by the traffic signs displayed.
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
5. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
6. The current works will be extended until the 4th of August 2024.
