## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - GLASSHOUSE WALK

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water maintenance and repair works to be carried out, Lambeth Borough Council, with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles (including cyclists) from entering in that length of Glasshquise Walk which lies between Albert Embankment and
- Goding Street.

  2. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- Alternative routes will be available for affected motor vehicles via Glasshouse Walk, Tyers Street, Black Prince Road, Kennington Road, Lambeth Road and Albert Embankment.
- 4. Alternative routes will be available for affected cyclists via (i)
- Glasshouse Walk, Vauxhall Walk, Tinworth Street and Albert Embankment; and (ii) Albert Embankment, New Spring Gardens Walk and Goding Street.

  5. The Order will come into force on 11th August 2024 and will
- continue for 1 month, or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will have effect on 11th August 2024 between 8am and 4.30pm, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order will also have effect on subsequent dates within that maximum period of 1 month.
