ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)

**(BELLENDEN ROAD, COBORG ROAD, CREBOR STREET, GORDON ROAD, KIRKWOOD ROAD,
HATFIELDS, ODESSA STREET, REDCROSS WAY)**

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable various works to be carried out, it intends, to make, an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in:
 - (a) Bellenden Road, between No's 85 and Holly Grove
 - (b) Coborg Road, between Loncroft Road and Neate Street
 - (c) Crebor Street, between Dunstans Road and Upland Road
 - (d) Gordon Road, at it's junction with Brayards Road
 - (e) Kirkwood Road, between Crewys Road and Brayards Road
 - (f) Hatfields, between Joan Street and Isabella Street
 - (g) Odessa Street, between No's 351 and No's 24
 - (h) Redcross Way, between Union Street and Southwark Street
3. The alternative routes for affected traffic for will be as indicated by the signs displayed
4. The existing 'one-way' working in Bellenden Road, will be made 'two-way' between Holly Grove and No's 83 and reverse the 'one-way' system between Chadwick Road and Blenheim Grove
5. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
6. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
7. The works will be in operation for (2a) 19th August (2b)22nd – 23rd August (2c) 22nd – 23rd August (2d) 21st – 22nd August (2e) 22nd – 23rd August (2f) 20th – 21st August (2g) 21st – 28th August (2h) 19th – 21st August
