ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (WESTMORELAND ROAD, CHERRILL STREET, ROBERTS CLOSE)

TEMPORARY WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice, that, it made, an order, the effect of which would be to introduce 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions
2. Whilst the restriction is in place, and whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to wait, including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading at any time in:
 - (a) Westmoreland Road, 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions will be introduced, from the end of the existing double yellow lines on the south side of the carriageway between Phelp Street and Portland Street,
 - (b)Cherill Street, 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions will be introduced, between Bradenham Close/Boundary Lane to it's blocked end of Cherrill Street including the turning head at it's junction with Slater Street on both sides of the carriageway (north and south side), excluding the inset bays
 - (c) Roberts Close, 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions will be introduced in it's ` tirety at the blocked/northern end of Roberts Close to the end of the existing double yellow lines near to Alfred Salter School
3. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, insofar as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
4. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
5. The restriction will come into force for (2a) 19th August 2024 - 18th February 2026 (2b) 19th August 2024 - 18th February 2026 (2c) 16th August 2024 – 15th February 2026
