 - The effect of the Order would be to temporarily:

 a) prohibit all motor vehicles (including motorcycles), from entering into, exiting from or proceeding in:
 - i) Blithdale Road outside No. 121;
 - b) replace the no entry restrictions with a prohibition of motor vehicles (including motorcycles) on:
 - i) Barth Road, outside No. 49; ii) Blithdale Road at its junction with Eynsham Road, outside No. 104 Blithdale Road.
- The Order would come into force on 29th August 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months, or until the Council decides the Order should end, whichever is the sooner. Alternative routes for diverted vehicles would be available via local roads.
