(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

- The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable various works to be carried out, it made, an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
- Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in:
 - Bellenden Road, between No's 85 and Holly Grove
 - Coborg Road, between Loncroft Road and Neate Street
 - Crebor Street, between Dunstons Road and Upland Road
 - Gordon Road, at it's junction with Brayards Road
 - Kirkwood Road, between Crewys Road and Brayards Road
 - Hatfields, between Joan Street and Isabella Street
 - Odessa Street, between No's 351 and No's 24
 - Redcross Way, between Union Street and Southwark Street
- The alternative routes for affected traffic for will be as indicated by the signs displayed
- The existing 'one-way' working in Bellenden Road, will be made 'two-way' between Holly Grove and No's 83 and reverse the 'one-way' system between Chadwick Road and Blenheim Grove
- Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
- The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- The works will be in operation for (2a) 19th August (2b)22nd – 23rd August (2c) 22nd – 23rd August (2d) 21st – 22nd August (2e) 22nd – 23rd August (2f) 20th – 21st August (2g) 21st – 28th August (2h) 19th – 21st August

TEMPORARY WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS)

- The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice, that, it made, an order, the effect of which would be to introduce 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions
- Whilst the restriction is in place, and whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to wait, including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading at any time in:
 - Westmoreland Road, 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions will be introduced, from the end of the existing double yellow lines on the south side of the carriageway between Phelps Street and Portland Street,
 - Cherill Street, 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions will be introduced, between Bradenham Close/Boundary Lane to it's blocked end of Cherrill Street including the turning head at it's junction with Slater Street on both sides of the carriageway (north and south side), excluding the inset bays
 - Roberts Close, 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions will be introduced in it's tirey at the blocked/northern end of Roberts Close to the end of the existing double yellow lines near to Alfred Salter School
- Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, insofar as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
- The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- The restriction will come into force for (2a) 19th August 2024 - 18th February 2026 (2b) 19th August 2024 - 18th February 2026 (2c) 16th August 2024 – 15th February 2026

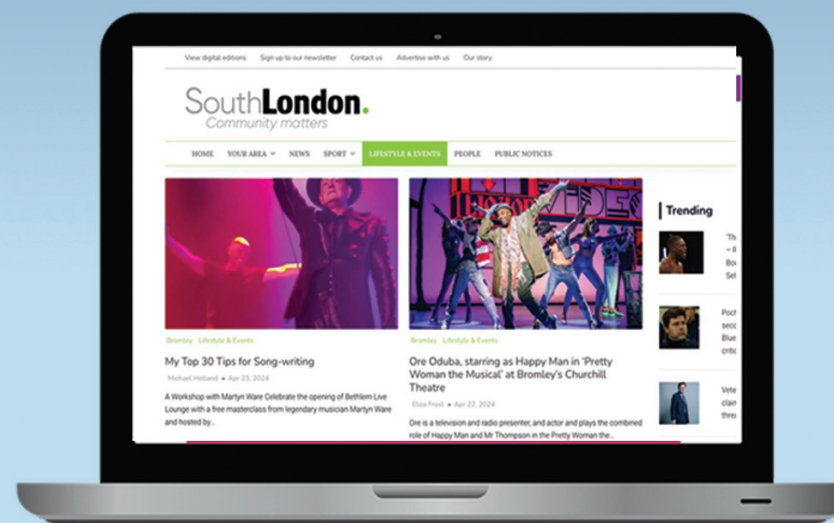
