What are Supplementary Planning Documents (SPDs)?

Supplementary planning documents (SPDs) are a material consideration in the plan-led decision-making process. This means the council will consider guidance within an SPD when assessing and determining a planning application.

SPDs cannot be used to introduce new planning policies and instead provide additional guidance on

existing policies in an adopted local plan.

The adopted local plan for Southwark is the <u>Southwark Plan 2022</u>. It was adopted by the Council Assembly on 23 February 2022, it sets out the vision, strategic objectives, and planning policies for

Assembly on 23 February 2022. It sets out the vision, strategic objectives, and planning policies for development in Southwark for the period 2019 to 2036.

The Southwark Plan 2022 is in conformity with the broader guidelines and policies set out in the London Plan 2021 and the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) 2023.
