ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)
(ASHBOURNE GROVE, LORDSHIP LANE)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, BUS LANE SUSPENSION)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable crane lifting works by Utility Construction Ltd, it intends to make an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time on Ashbourne Grove at the junction with Lordship Lane.
3. The alternative route for affected traffic will be shown by the signs displayed.
4. The bus lane restriction on Lordship Lane at the junction of Ashbourne Grove will be suspended during whilst works are in progress.
5. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
6. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
7. The order will be in place between the 21st of October and the 24th of October 2024. Works will only be carried out between the hours of 20:00 and 06:00 each night, beginning at 20:00 on the 21st and ending at 06:00 on the 24th of October.
