ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) **(HYNDMAN ROAD, GREAT SUFFOLK STREET)**

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable utility work to be carried out by Thames Water or its appointed contractor, it intends to make an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time on:
 - (a) Hyndman Road, southbound carriageway between Ruby Street and Old Kent Road.
 - (b) Great Suffolk Street, at the side of 200 Union Street.
3. The alternative routes for affected traffic will be shown by the traffic signs displayed.
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
5. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
6. The prohibitions will be in place on the following dates:
 - (a) 4th to 6th November 2024
 - (b) 12th to 25th November 2024
