ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)
(PARKERS ROW, WOLSELEY STREET, CAMBERWELL STATION ROAD, CONTENT STREET,
DISNEY STREET, DISNEY PLACE, LARCOM STREET)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable highways or resurfacing works by Conways, it has made an order, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time on:
 - (a) Parkers Row, between Wolseley street and Dockhead.
 - (b) Wolseley Street, from Mill Street to Outside Ship Aground Pub
 - (c) Camberwell Station Road, from Camberwell Station Road to 10 metres past Knatchbull Road.
 - (d) Camberwell Station Road, between Woodrow Court and Post Office building.
 - (e) Content Street, directional closure, southbound traffic prohibited for whole length.
 - (f) Larcom Street, between Content Street and Brandon Street
 - (g) Disney Place, whole road.
 - (h) Disney Street, whole road.
3. The alternative route for affected traffic will be shown by the signs displayed.
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
5. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
6. The prohibitions will be in place on the following dates:
 - (a & b) 1st of November 2024
 - (c) 4th and 5th November 2024
 - (d) 5th November 2024 to 15th January 2025
 - (e & f) 4th November to 19th December 2024
 - (g & h) 4th and 5th November 2024
