ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3220 GLA ROAD (WARWICK ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2024

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the abovenamed Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable traffic signal detector works to take place on A3220 Warwick Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle travelling in a northwesterly direction from turning left from A3220 Warwick Road onto A4 West Cromwell Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 14th October 2024 until 18th October 2024 every night from 8:00 PM to 2:00 AM or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Warwick Road, Kensington High Street, Warwick Gardens, Pembroke Road, Earl's Court Road, West Cromwell Road to normal route of travel.
