- TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE HINTON ROAD

 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable bridge inspection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Hinton Road which lies between the junction of Wellfit Street, travelling south-eastward for a distance of approximately 70 metres.
- An alternative route for vehicles would be available via Wanless Road, Herne Hill Road and Coldharbour Lane and vice versa.
 The restrictions would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- The order would come into force on 26th November 2024 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies). In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 10 pm on 26th November 2024 and 6 am on 27th
