ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – JASPER ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunications repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of the London Borough of Southwark, have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Jasper Road which lies between Westow Hill and a point 20 metres north of Westow Hill.
2. Alternative routes for vehicles will be available via a) Jasper Road, Farquhar Road, Dulwich Wood Avenue, Colby Road, Gipsy Road and Westow Hill and; b) Westow Hill, Crystal Palace Parade, Farquhar Road and Jasper Road .
3. The restrictions will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order will come into force on 10th December 2024 and will continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies). In practice it is anticipated that the works will only take place nightly between 9 pm and 5 am from 10th to 12th December 2024 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 1 month.
