Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised signs, cones or road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time on Friern Road, in the southbound lane of Friern road between Number 213 and the junction with Etherow Street. The northbound carriageway lane will be open.

The alternative routes for affected traffic will be shown by the traffic signs displayed. 4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.

- 5 Parking, loading and waiting restrictions will be introduced for the duration of the works on both sides of the carriageway between Etherow Street and number 213 Friern Road. 6 The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or
- for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- The prohibitions and restrictions will be in place between the 5th of November and the 21st of 7 December 2024.
