ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (GOODRICH ROAD, SOUTHWARK PARK ROAD)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable highways and resurfacing works by Conways, it intends to make an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
- 2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time on (a) Goodrich Road, between Lordship Lane and Crystal Palace Road. (b) Southwark Park Road, from the junction of Galleywall Road to the junction with Raymouth Road
- The alternative routes for affected traffic will be: a) Goodrich Road, Lordship Lane, Heber Road, Crystal Palace Road or Lordship Lane, Crystal Palace Road. b) Tower Bridge Road, Abbey Street, Jamaica Road, Southwark Park Road.
- Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
- The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- 6. The prohibitions will be in place on (a) 2nd and 3rd of December 2024 (b) 20:00 on the 5th of December until 05:00 on the 6th of December 2024.
