RED POST HILL JUNCTION IMPROVEMENTS

The London Borough of Southwark (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Red Post Hill junction) Order 2024

1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that on 7 November 2024 it has made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The effects of the Order, to accommodate kerb-line build-outs (footway widening) at the junction of Red Post Hill, East Dulwich Grove, Dulwich Village and Village Way and to make the junction safer for all users, are to: -
 - (a) extend existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines 'DYLs') on both sides of each road at the junction to accommodate the kerb-line changes in (i) EAST DULWICH GROVE, (ii) DULWICH VILLAGE, and (iii) VILLAGE WAY;
 - (b) extend existing 'DYLs' and contiguous 'at any time' loading restrictions (double kerb blips 'DKBs') on both sides of RED POST HILL at the junction with East Dulwich Grove, Dulwich Village and Village Way to accommodate the kerb-line changes;
 - (c) add 14.5 metres new 'DYLs' in EAST DULWICH GROVE north-west side o/s No. 166 East Dulwich Grove; and
 - (d) on existing 'DYLs' add new 'timed' loading restrictions (single kerb blips 'SKBs') operating between the hours of 7 am to 10 am and 4 pm to 7 pm every day of the week (i) 71 metres in DULWICH VILLAGE north-east side o/s Nos. 1 to 9 Dulwich Village, and (ii) 40 metres in VILLAGE WAY south-east side at the junction with East Dulwich Grove, Dulwich Village and Red Post Hill.Notes: (1) 'at any time' means at all hours on every day of the week. (2) 'DYLs' refer to 'at any time' waiting restrictions, 'SKBs' refer to timed loading restrictions and 'DKBs' refer to 'at any time' loading restrictions. (3) All measurements are in metres and are approximate.
3. 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
