LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

- The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable resurfacing works by Zack Contractors, it has made an order, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
- Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time on Tanner Street, between Riley Road and Maltby Street.
- The alternative route for affected traffic will be Maltby Street, Abbey Street and Riley Road.
 Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
- The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- 6. The road closure will be in place between the 18th and 29th of November 2024.
