ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A41 GLA ROAD (BAKER STREET, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the abovenamed Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Water Mains maintenance works on the A41 Baker Street
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding on the northbound carriageway of Baker Street between its junctions with Marylebone Road and Park Road/Allsop Place.
 - The Order will be effective from 7:00 AM on 25th November 2024 until 7:00 PM on 14th February 2025, or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes:
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs: via Baker Street (Southern Arm), York Street and Gloucester Place to normal route of travel.
