- of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an order the effect of which will be, on Vauxhall Street, between the junction of Kennington Lane and Kennington Oval, to temporarily impose a rolling suspension of the contra-flow cycle lane, and where the cycle lane is suspended, permit cycles to travel south to north. 2. Alternative routes are not applicable.
- 3. The conditions of this Order will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs, or the use of temporary traffic signals.
- 3. The Order will come into force on 9th December 2024 and will continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have

been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will take place on 9th December 2024 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on this day then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 6 months.
