ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (SURREY SQUARE)

(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that, it intends, to make an order, to implement the following restrictions in part of the above named road. This is to allow for the continuation of the previous experimental order: (Pedestrian and cycle zones) (Surrey Square Primary School) Experimental Traffic Order 2023, LBS 2023/040)
2. The effect of the order:-
 - (a) in SURREY SQUARE between the south-western kerb-line of Flinton Street and its south-western extremity (which includes the entirety of ALSACE ROAD, ALVEY STREET, and SURREY GROVE).
 - (b) School Streets Programme', prohibits all motor vehicles, except permit holders, from entering a pedestrian and cycle zone in SURREY SQUARE in the vicinity of Surrey Square Primary School between 8.30 am and 9.15 am, and between 3.00 pm and 3.45 pm on Mondays to Fridays, during school term time (as determined by the school), in the London Borough of Southwark.
3. Nothing in this article shall apply to any vehicle being used by the fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
4. The restriction will come into force between the 3rd January 2025 – 2nd July 2026
5. The alternative route will be via: Trafalgar Avenue, Albany Road, Old Kent Road
