### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

#### TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS ON BRIXTON STATION ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to facilitate access to the railway signal, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth made an Order, the general effect of which will be in: -
2. Brixton Station Road, between No. 53 Brixton Station Road and the junction of Valentia Place, (a) to ban vehicles from entering, parking, waiting, loading, and unloading; and (b) close the footway on the south (rail arch) side with pedestrians diverted to the north side.
3. Suspend one-way working and introduce two-way working; (a) on Popes Road between the junctions of Canterbury Crescent and Brixton Station Road; and (b) Brixton Station Road between the junction of Popes Road and No. 53 Brixton Station Road.
4. Suspend the cycle lane on Brixton Station Road in both directions.
5. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Popes Road, Canterbury Crescent and Gresham Road and vice versa.
6. The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
7. The Order comes into force on 11 March 2025 and continues for a maximum duration of 1 month, or until the works have been completed whichever is sooner.
