ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) **(DERWENT GROVE, BARGE HOUSE STREET, NEEDLEMAN STREET,** **ROTHERHITHE NEW ROAD)**

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable various works to be carried out, it intends, to make an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in:
 - (2a) Derwent Grove, cycle at it's junction with Grove Vale for 30m south (cyclists)
 - (2b) Barge House Street, between both junctions of Upper Ground (North/East corner of No's 26 to West face of No's 34)
 - (2c) Needleman Street, between Christopher Close and Albatross Way
 - (2d) Rotherhithe New Road, (cycle lane closure) by the bottom of the roundabout, from both sides of the pedestrian crossing.
3. The alternative routes for affected traffic will be (2a) Melbourne Grove, East Dulwich Grove (cyclists) (2b) Upper Ground (2c) Poolmans Street, Timber Pond Road, Lagado Mews, Salter Road, Lower Road (2d) as indicated by the signs displayed.
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
5. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
6. The closure will be in operation on the following dates: (2a) 30th April – 15th May (2b) 22nd April – 27th July (2c) 28th April – 2nd July (2d) 22nd – 25th April
