(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

- The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable various works to be carried out, it made, an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
- Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in:
 - (2a) Harper Road, between New Kent Road and County Street.
 - (2b) Surrey Quays Road, at it's junction with Deal Porters Way.
 - (2c) Peckham Rye, between Whorlton Road and Scylla Road
 - (2d) Snowsfields, at it's junction with Kipling Street
- The alternative routes for affected traffic will be (2a) New Kent Road, Great Dover Street, Borough High Street, Harper Road (2b) Surrey Quays Road, Lower Road, Brunel Road, Salter Road, Redriff Road, Lower Road, Bush Road, Rotherhithe Old Road (2c) Nunhead Lane, Consort Road, Heaton Road, Rye Lane, Peckham Rye. East Dulwich Road, Peckham Rye (2d) as indicated by the signs displayed
- Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
- The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- The closure will be in operation on the following dates: (2a) 28th April – 7th May (2b) 12th – 13th April with back up dates of 19th – 20th April and 10th – 11th May (2c) 12th – 13th April, with back up dates of the 10th – 11th May (2d) 12th – 13th April, with back up dates of 19th – 20th April.
