ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A232 GLA ROAD (CROYDON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SUTTON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2025

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable electric vehicle charging point installation works to take place on A232 Croydon Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping:
 - (1) at the kerb stretching from the southern side of Croydon Road, outside No.4 Croydon Road to the eastern side of Plough Lane, outside No.17 The Broadway Plough Lane;
 - (2) in the Parking and Disabled Person's vehicles bay opposite Nos.9-13 The Broadway Plough Lane.

The Order will be effective at certain times 7:00 AM on 19th May 2025 until 7:00 PM on 19th May 2026 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
