ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A202 GLA SIDE ROAD (BOLTON CRESCENT, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2025

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water works to take place on Bolton Crescent.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning left into Bolton Crescent from A202 Camberwell New Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 8:00 PM on 30th June 2025 until 5:30 AM on 2nd July 2025 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Camberwell New Road, John Ruskin Street, Dale Road, Cooks Road, Kennington Park Place and St Agnes Place to normal route of travel.
