and unloading at any time in:

single yellow lines will be converted to 'at any-time' restrictions (double yellow lines) along with new or extended lengths. (2b) Swan Street, at it's junction with Harper Road, (north and south side) 13.5m of existing single yellow lines will be converted to 'at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines). (2c) Harper Road, 7 pay by phone/permit bays located between Newington Causeway and Swan Street (north side) will be suspended. 3. The alternative route for affected traffic (2a) not applicable

(2a) Harper Road, at it's junction with Borough High Street and Swan Street (north side) existing

- Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it 4. is practical without interference with the execution of the said works. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or 5. for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the
- direction of a police constable in uniform. The restriction will be in operation on the 7th August 2025 – 6th February 2027 6.
